Buenos Aires, Argentina

Tag 1

Welcome to Buenos Aires, where you'll stay overnight. Perhaps, plan to spend some time in the city, nicknamed the 'Paris of South America'. Resplendent with Belle Epoque buildings, sidewalk cafes and green spaces, there's the fiery passion of Latin America – a collective love for football, flame-cooked meats (asado) and the tango.

Some of the highlights are La Boca, a colourful, creative mecca with a must-do art walk, and San Telmo, a former aristocratic neighbourhood that was abandoned during a 19th-century epidemic. Mansions were turned into conventillos (shared housing), boutique hotels, antique shops, and tango clubs, exuding a captivating bohemian vibe.

Fly from Buenos Aires to Ushuaia, the capital of Tierra del Fuego and the southernmost city in the world.

Cruise through the legendary waters of Cape Horn, where the Atlantic and Pacific Oceans meet at the southernmost point of South America. The collision of these two oceans is a spectacular display of nature's force and a great place to spot sea lions, penguins and whales.

Continue through the Beagle Channel, tracing the southern edge of Patagonia, and named after the ship that carried Charles Darwin on his five-year discovery journey. Admire the dramatic views of the Andean mountains from the comfort of your ultra-luxury Discovery Yacht.

Join an introductory presentation by the Discovery Team in the state-of-the-art theatre. Learn about the journey ahead through Chilean Patagonia and towards the polar frontier and feel the excitement building as they explain how the Discovery Excursions will work in the coming days.

The theatre is where you can listen to lectures, enjoy movies and documentaries during the day. As night falls, experience unforgettable performances—from dazzling musical theatre and cabaret to electrifying pop, dance and interactive game shows.

Weather and sea conditions permitting, you may get the opportunity to explore this remote archipelago, celebrated for its breathtaking beauty and dramatic landscapes. Join activities organized by the Discovery Team, such as a hike to the lighthouse and a visit to the Cape Horn Monument.

Tag 4

As you cruise through this remarkable region, witness Seno Garibaldi, one of a handful of advancing glaciers in the world. Continue to Seno Pia Glacier, where you'll have the chance to explore its striking ice crevasses and meandering rivers. This spectacular area, recognised as a World Heritage-listed Biosphere Reserve, teems with marine life—including seals, sea lions, and a variety of seabirds—while the majestic Andean condor soars overhead.

Watch the breathtaking scenery slip by as you relax in a cabana on Deck 10. Alternatively, ask your butler to bring afternoon tea to your suite and relax on your private verandah.

Scenic Discovery:

Get ready in your Discovery attire and join your Discovery Team for Zodiac cruising near the Seno Garibaldi and Seno Pia glaciers. Sit in silence and listen for the crack or thunder of a calving. If you're wanting a more active adventure, enjoy kayaking around the bergy bits.

Towering peaks rise dramatically above glacial-blue waters, leading to the awe-inspiring Agostini Glacier — a shimmering cascade of ice spilling from the rugged Darwin Mountain Range. As you cruise through this remote wonderland, keep your eyes peeled for playful seals, soaring seabirds, and majestic humpback whales in their pristine habitat.

Scenic Discovery:

Seize the opportunity to explore your destination through a variety of exciting activities organised by the expert Discovery Team. During the evening recap, the Discovery Leader will share insights from the day's experiences and provide a preview of what's to come.

Punta Arenas, Chile

Punta Arenas is located at the southern extreme of Chile, in the heart of Patagonia, and serves as the gateway into Antarctica as well as Torres del Paine National Park. Overlooking the Strait of Magellan, this historic port flourished during the California Gold Rush – its prime position served as a haven for ships. The city will delight with its clean air, sophisticated European architecture and wildlife.

When back on board, you may wish to book a treatment# at the tranquil Senses Spa. Perhaps indulge in an ESPA facial# or an alternative therapy including Ayurvedic massages #.

Late in the evening, we'll cruise the legendary Strait of Magellan, once the main passage between the Atlantic and Pacific Oceans before the Panama Canal. Follow the historic routes of explorers Ferdinand Magellan and Sir Francis Drake.

Scenic Freechoice:

Punta Arenas on Foot

Discover the history and charm of Punta Arenas on a guided walk through the heart of Patagonia's southernmost city. Visit the Shepherd Monument and the Maggiorino Borgatello Museum before strolling along lively Bories Street. Climb to Cerro de la Cruz for panoramic views of the Strait of Magellan, then end your tour at the elegant Plaza de Armas, where historic buildings and the monument to Ferdinand Magellan reflect the city's rich heritage.

Activity level: Moderate, Duration: 3 hours

Magellan's Discovery and Nao Victoria

Step back into the Age of Exploration on this fascinating journey through Punta Arenas. Visit the Nao Victoria Museum to explore full-size replicas of historic sailing ships, including Magellan's famous vessel. Continue to the Maggiorino Borgatello Museum to discover Patagonia's natural and cultural heritage, then enjoy panoramic views from Cerro de la Cruz before a brief stop at the elegant Plaza de Armas.

Activity Level: Moderate, Duration: 3 hours

Patagonian Estancia Experience

Discover authentic Patagonian ranch life with a visit to Estancia Olga Teresa, a family-owned sheep farm set amid the vast southern plains. Meet your welcoming hosts, watch traditional sheep-shearing and sheepdog demonstrations, and learn about the region's ranching heritage. Complete your visit with a delicious Patagonian lamb barbecue, served with local specialties, while enjoying the warm hospitality and spectacular scenery of rural Chile.

Activity level: Easy, Duration: 6 hours 30 mins

Anchored: 06:00 - 20:00

Tag 6

Cruising Chilean Fjords

Navigate the labyrinth of the Patagonian fjords of southern Chile – their long narrow inlets and steep cliffs, channels and islands all carved by glaciers. From the Observation Deck with its commanding view of the bow, marvel at the towering peaks, cascading waterfalls, and dense forests of this pristine wilderness. When not covered in ice, the shore is a unique mix of temperate and Sub-Antarctic flora, from deciduous beech trees to edible Calafate berries.

Stay alert for delightful sightings of elephant seals, dolphins, and majestic whales gracefully accompanying your voyage – use your complimentary in-suite binoculars to find these as they blend into the landscape.

Savour the relaxed atmosphere at the Yacht Club as you enjoy al fresco dining. Featuring grilled-to-perfection meats, fresh seafood and seasonal produce, it's ideal for a leisurely lunch or a laid-back dinner under the stars.

Tag 7

Pio XI Glacier (Inner Fjords) > Puerto Eden

Cruise deep into Patagonia's Inner Fjords and the English Narrows, which is home to remote Puerto Eden. This is the only settlement inside the Chilean Inside Passage, a region with a mountainous terrain and a thriving Magellanic sub-polar forest. You will be able to learn about the ancient Mapuche culture, navigate the town's intricate wooden boardwalks and see its native wildlife.

Witness the stunning Pio XI Glacier, which is nestled within the Bernardo O'Higgins National Park, in the heart of Chilean Patagonia, and spans the size of Santiago. Also known as Bruggen Glacier, this exceptional wonder is the sole glacier on Earth that is expanding daily.

Take the opportunity to explore your destination through a variety of exciting experiences organised by the Discovery Team. During the evening recap, the Discovery Leader will share insights from the day's excursions and provide a preview of what's to come.

Churches of Chiloé and City of Castro

Explore the cultural heart of Chiloé Island as you visit the charming towns of Chonchi and Castro. Back in Castro, admire the colorful palafitos from Gamboa Viewpoint before visiting the striking San Francisco Cathedral. After the tour, you may return to the pier or stay in town to browse Castro's lively handicraft market.

Activity level: Easy, Duration: 3 hours 30 mins

Cucao Chiloé National Park

Discover the wild beauty of Chiloé National Park on a scenic journey through one of Chile's most treasured natural landscapes. Puerto Montt, Chile

A busy town in the Chilean Lake District, Puerto Montt sits near the end of the Pan-American Highway – this legendary stretch of road begins in Alaska and continues to Ushuaia in Argentina. Framed by snow-capped volcanoes and lush green landscapes, it serves as a gateway to the stunning Andean Alps. Stroll along its bustling waterfront, explore colourful markets brimming with artisan crafts and fresh seafood.

As you enjoy your time on board your Discovery Yacht, you may wish to visit the state-of-the-art gym for an invigorating workout or the studio for a Pilates class, some guided stretching or aerial yoga.

Scenic Freechoice:

Volcano Osorno and Petrohué Falls

Discover two of Chile's most spectacular natural landmarks on a scenic journey through the Lake District. Admire the breathtaking Petrohué Falls, where brilliant turquoise waters surge through ancient volcanic rock, before continuing to the slopes of the majestic Osorno Volcano. At La Burbuja, approximately 1,200 metres above sea level, enjoy panoramic views of the Petrohué Valley, surrounding lakes, and snow-capped peaks before returning to Puerto Montt.

Activity level: Moderate, Duration: 5 hours 45 mins

Puerto Montt, Puerto Varas and Frutillar

Explore the highlights of Chile's picturesque Lake District on a scenic journey through Puerto Montt, Puerto Varas, and Frutillar. Valdivia by Land and River

Discover Valdivia by both land and water on this scenic excursion. Cruise along the Valdivia River, passing historic fortifications, islands, shipyards, and elegant riverside homes before arriving in the city. Stroll through the lively market, watch sea lions basking along the waterfront, and explore the city centre. Your journey concludes with a visit to the Maurice Van de Maele Historical and Anthropological Museum, showcasing Valdivia's rich cultural heritage.

Activity level: Moderate, Duration: 4 hours

Punta Curinanco Trek

Explore the unspoilt beauty of Punta Curinanco Nature Reserve on an invigorating trek through one of the world's rare Valdivian temperate rainforests. Follow forest trails beneath towering trees, discover rich native flora and birdlife, and enjoy spectacular scenery where lush wilderness meets the rugged Pacific coastline. Activity level: Active, Duration: 3 hours 45 mins

Angachilla River by Kayak

After a scenic drive through Valdivia and a safety briefing, explore the peaceful waterways of the Black Forest, surrounded by lush vegetation and abundant birdlife. Spend approximately 2.5 hours on the water before relaxing with a light snack, then return to the pier with lasting memories of southern Chile's spectacular natural landscapes.

Valdivian Beer Tasting & German Heritage
